## Cap-and-Trade Program Vintage 2025 Allocation Summary

This document provides a summary of vintage 2025 allowance allocation under the Cap-and-Trade Program (Program) aggregated by sector. Industrial allowance allocation data are disaggregated by general industrial activity. Allowance allocation methodologies for each sector can be found in <a href="Cap-and-Trade Regulation">Cap-and-Trade Regulation</a> (Regulation) sections 95890 through 95895. Details on allowance allocation to electrical distribution utilities (EDU) are not included in this document and are instead posted online at <a href="Post-2020 EDU Allocation Table (EDU)">Post-2020 EDU Allocation Table (EDU)</a>.

Because facility-level allowance allocation data could reveal confidential business information, the allocations to each industrial sector presented in Table 1 below are aggregated so that they include at least five companies. The paper manufacturing sector no longer has five covered facilities, and the remaining facilities are now included in the miscellaneous manufacturing sector.

Entities that received no vintage 2025 allocation or that have a negative allocation balance that will carry over to next year do not appear in this document. Also, pursuant to section 95835(c), an entity with emissions below the Program inclusion threshold for a full compliance period may request to exit the Program. Facilities exiting the Program are not eligible to receive allowance allocation and do not appear in this document.

The "Total Allocation" values in Table 1 are the sum of vintage 2025 allowances allocated to eligible entities. "Total Allocation" values exclude any negative allocation balance that will carry over to next year. "Total Allocation" values include allowances that have true-up value. Vintage 2025 allowances with true-up value are eligible to be used for compliance for covered emissions in 2023 and subsequent years, and the quantity "Total True-Up Value" is a subset of "Total Allocation" in Table 1.

The vintage 2025 allowance allocation to electrical distribution utilities in Table 1 reflects a reduction from the total amount in Table 9-4 of the Regulation to account for 2023 Energy Imbalance Market (EIM) Outstanding Emissions. CARB directly retired these allowances for EIM Outstanding Emissions in 2023 as required by sections 95852(I)(2) and 95892(a)(3) of the Regulation to address emissions leakage related to operation of the EIM.
