


#### **Translating Audio**



#### **CARB's Mission**

CARB is charged with protecting the public from harmful air pollution and climate change.





#### **CARB's Vision for Racial Equity**

CARB works toward a future where all Californians breathe healthy and clean air, benefit from actions to address climate change, and where race is no longer a predictor of life outcomes.



# **CARB's Commitments to Organizational Change**

#### **CARB Resolution 20-33**

Establish and advance racial equity in social justice measures in all CARB actions.

#### **Governor's Executive Order N-16-22**

Directs state agencies to develop or update strategic plans that advance equity and respond to identified disparities.



# **CARB's Approach to Advancing Racial Equity**

#### Normalize

- Use a shared racial equity framework
- Operate with urgency and accountability

#### Organize

- Build organizational capacity
- Partnerships with communities and other external partners

#### Operationalize

- Use racial equity tools
- Be data-driven





# **Operationalizing Racial Equity at CARB**

#### What Are Racial Equity Tools?

Racial equity tools are a set of methodologies that can be used to identify and mitigate systemic biases within policies, programs, and practices.

#### Why Develop CARB's Racial Equity Lens?

Racial equity tools, like CARB's Racial Equity Lens, offer data-driven strategies to help lead with race in the development and implementation of their work.




#### What is CARB's Racial Equity Lens (REL)?

CARB's Racial Equity Lens (REL) is a series of racial equity-centered, data-driven questions that can be tailored to the needs of CARB's many divisions, programs, and processes.

# How does the Office of Racial Equity (ORE) support CARB's REL?

- Coordinate **agency-wide implementation** of CARB's REL
- Externally ground truth CARB's REL with community experts
- Launch CARB's (revised) REL, both internally and externally
- Support **sustained use** of CARB's REL **and iterative refinement**



# **Ground Truthing CARB's REL**

#### What is ground truthing?

*Ground truthing is* a process that informs the development of a project based on lived and on-the-ground experiences.

#### Why is CARB ground truthing CARB's REL?

Ground truthing ensures that CARB's REL is effective and viable, not only in theory but also in practice, and that staff's application of the tool achieves the outcomes communities are most interested in.



# What would ground truthing CARB's REL look like?

CARB is seeking 5 community experts to externally ground truth CARB's REL. Community experts will **participate in four meetings**, review materials provided by CARB staff, and **share written feedback outside of meetings** 

Anticipated time commitment: March 10 -June 27 (approximately 4 months)

Compensation: **\$2,500** + covered travel for one in-person meeting

# Who should apply to ground truth CARB's REL?

Community experts should:

- Be able to demonstrate a proven track record of a commitment to racial equity and environmental justice.
- Have a vision for CARB to advance racial equity and be willing to share that vision.
- Experience or expertise working with government organizations.
- Connection or expertise with disadvantaged, low-income communities




