





Background

- SB 350 Barriers Study priority recommendation
- Streamline access and coordinate outreach for clean transportation incentives in priority communities
- \$22.675 million allocated to-date
- Administered by GRID Alternatives



Background

- Pilot phase of project developed two main components:
 - Statewide network of outreach partners 31 community-based organizations currently
 - Streamlined application webtool (Benefits Finder) and case management team
- Also piloted capacity building grant program for community-based organizations



Background

- Streamlined application webtool:
 - Original goal for fully centralized application was infeasible
 - Technological integration challenges
 - Legal and privacy concerns over shared ownership of data
 - Project requirements varied and changed too frequently
 - Adapted to challenges by centralizing income verification as a universal first step, then applicants are routed to individual programs
 - Team prioritized other components of the project to respond to stakeholder and applicant feedback

Current Program Implementation Process

- GRID Alternatives intakes clients through Outreach Partner Network
- Determines interest and checks eligibility for various incentive programs through Benefits Finder tool
- Completes income verification process
- Routes to program administrator to complete application
- Provides case management support to applicant throughout process



Proposed Change to Program Implementation

- Same: GRID Alternatives intakes clients through Outreach Partner Network
- Same: Determines interest and checks eligibility for various incentive programs through Benefits Finder tool
- Change: No income verification. Routes individuals directly to program administrator website to start application
- Provide enhanced case management to support PA teams



Impacts

- Removing income verification frees up resources
- From the client perspective, is less duplicative and clarifies roles between Access Clean California and Program Administrator teams
- Increased resources for outreach to potential clients in underserved communities
 - More funding to flow directly to outreach partners to provide hands on help for clients
- Increased resources for case management support
- Deepen equity by reaching the highest need clients
