Hello Courtney,

Thank you for the submission. CARB approves this request from Equilon Enterprises (dba Shell Oil Products US) ("Shell") to extend the Prospective Eligibility granted on December 26, 2024, for vessel visits to Shell Mormon Island Terminal to use the remediation fund compliance option. CARB also recognizes Shell's intention to use the contracted barge for emissions capture as soon as it receives CARB Executive Order approval.

Original eligibility period: January 1 – March 31, 2025 Extended eligibility period: January 1 – July 30, 2025

All the terms and conditions from CARB's letter dated December 26, 2024 (attached), except the new end date of **July 30, 2025**, continue to apply during Shell's extended Prospective Eligibility period. If CAECS service is not yet available for any/all visits to Shell's Terminal by the end date of the requested eligibility period, Shell may reapply to receive another prospective eligibility determination for an additional period.
