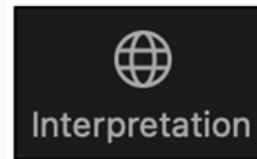

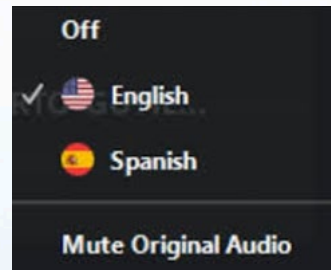
Accessing Zoom from a computer

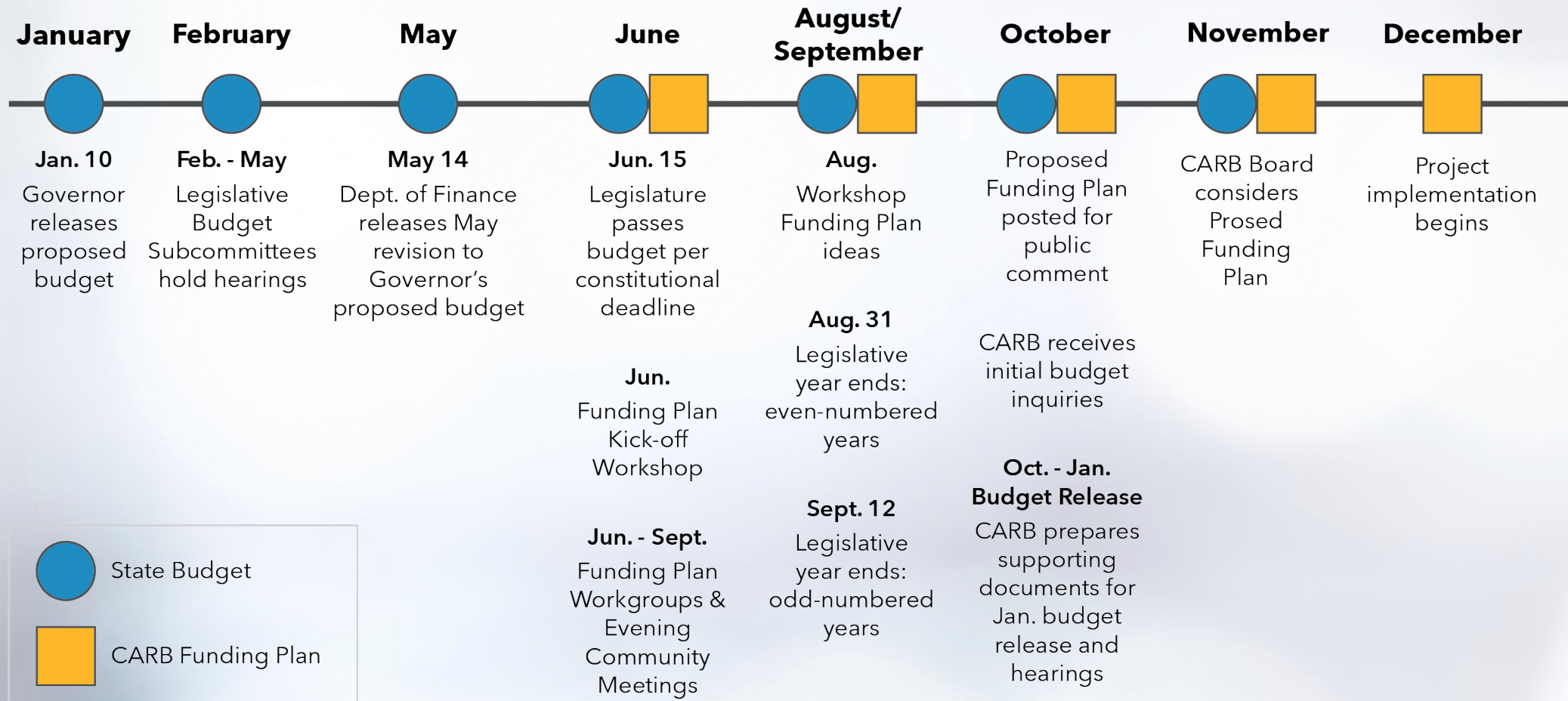

May Budget Revision for Clean Transportation Incentives

State Budget & Funding Plan Process Overview

General Timeline



May Revision Budget Proposal for Clean Transportation Incentives

Funding Category	Governor's January Budget Proposal	May Revision
Zero-Emission Drayage	\$48 million	TBD
Community-Based Plans, Projects, and Support/Sustainable Community Strategies	\$100 million	TBD
Emerging Opportunities	\$47 million	TBD
Charter Boat Compliance	\$20 million	TBD
Air Quality Improvement Program	\$35 million	TBD

Early Appropriation:

- An additional \$17 million for regional Clean Cars 4 All was appropriated in an early action budget bill on April 14, 2025
 - Total of \$19.8M
 - Funding to be prioritized for districts with oversubscribed programs

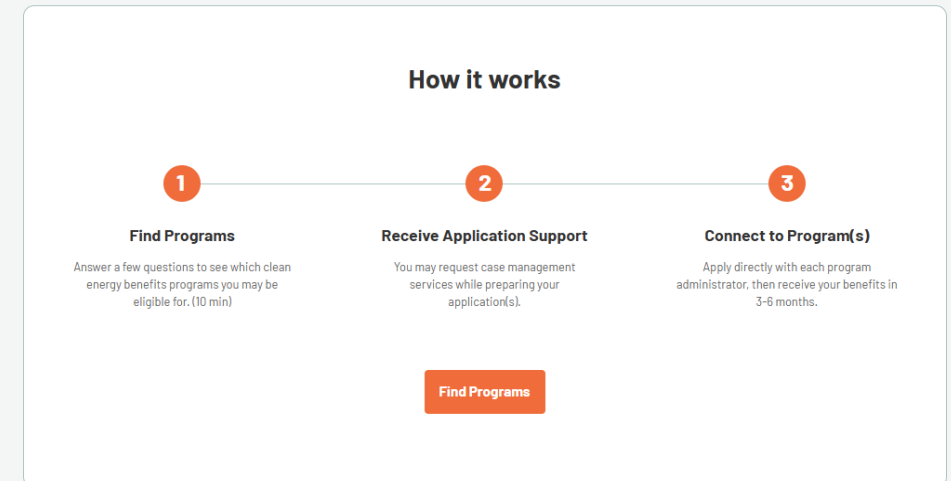
Public Workgroup Summary on Access Clean California Program

- Meeting held **February 26, 2025** to discuss implementation changes to the Access Clean California Program
- **Purpose of Access Clean California:** Streamline access and coordinate outreach for clean transportation incentives in priority communities
- **\$22.675** allocated to date
- Program run by **GRID Alternatives**

Public Workgroup Summary on Access Clean California Program (contd).

- Pilot phase of project developed two main components:
 - Statewide network of outreach partners – 31 community-based organizations currently
 - Streamlined application webtool (**Benefits Finder**) and case management team to support applicants
- Also piloted a capacity building grant program for community-based organizations

We connect people with low- to moderate-income to clean energy programs. Our Benefits Finder will show you all the programs you may be eligible for and how they can be combined.



Public Workgroup Summary on Access Clean California Program (contd).

- Evolution of the streamlined application webtool:
 - Original goal for a fully centralized application was infeasible
 - Moved to centralized income verification checks based on public feedback
- Reflections on process to date:
 - Centralized income verification requires a lot of time and resources
 - Changes to CARB's portfolio of incentive projects means centralized income verification is now an unnecessary step for most applicants
- Moving Forward:
 - Program administrator to focus resources on **enhanced case management support**, and leave income verification to individual programs
- Impacts:
 - Increased resources for **outreach** to potential clients in priority communities
 - More hands-on support for clients, **deepen equity** by reaching highest need clients

Access Clean California Case Management Support Examples

- What is offered:
 - **Information** on program offerings and specifics
 - **Communication** across the entire application journey
 - **Advocacy** for specific client needs
 - **Actions:** Sharing concrete next steps through providing website links, materials, simplified process documents
 - "Application Hack" **Tip sheets**
 - **Video and phone calls**, texting support
 - **Tutorials** for document uploads
