



Responses to questions regarding the F-Gas Reduction Incentive Program (FRIP) solicitation for synthetic refrigerant degradation products literature review and white paper

Q1. What are the proposal requirements with regards to page limitations, page formatting, etc.?

A1. There are no specific formatting requirements for submitted proposals, but proposals should follow accepted standard formatting practices (like APA, MLA, Chicago, etc.). While there isn't a required number of pages, less than 20 pages is desirable.

Q2. Are the references attesting to the organization's or the principal investigator's abilities to deliver similar projects successfully?

A2. References should attest to the principal investigator's abilities primarily. The reference may also attest to the organization's ability, but the principal investigator should be the focus of the reference.

Q3. Could you please clarify the expected timeline of the literature review - is the draft white paper supposed to be delivered by November 2025, or the final copy? Does "by November 2025" mean October 31, or November 30?

A3. In order to meet the submittal deadline of November 30, 2025, for the final copy, the draft white paper must be submitted by October 31. The October 31 draft deadline is to allow sufficient time for the final white paper to incorporate edits as requested.
