In response to your April 23, 2025 email correspondence, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) has revised the stationary engine family list for the DCL International Inc. Mine-X Sootfilter® diesel particulate filter verification and issued the attached Executive Order (EO) DE-08-002-07.

The amended EO includes additional engine families for model year 2025. Of the 99 engine families requested by DCL, 77 that met all the EO criteria were added to the engine family list. The remaining 22 engine families did not meet the EO criteria and therefore were not added to the verified list for the following reasons:

- 14 engine families equipped with exhaust gas recirculation.
- Four engine families exceed the verification particulate matter limit of 0.15 grams per brake horsepower hour.
- Four engine families were tested only under variable speed test cycles which are not consistent with the required constant speed ISO 8178 D2 steady state cycles outlined in the EO criteria.
