Evaluated best available retrofit control technology requirements, the implementation of best available retrofit control technology and associated existing and potential rules. Educated and received Board Approval for participation. Continued outreach on our website soliciting for feedback.

**V. Grant funds remaining and expended:**

Staff time for the FY 18/19 grant covered 2/1/19 to 6/27/20. Staff time for the FY 19/20 grant covered 6/28/20 to 6/26/21. Staff time for the FY 20/21 grant covered 6/27/21 to 7/31/22 totaling 151 hours. Any remaining balance from this account will likely be transferred to the District Woodsmoke Reduction Program. Staff time in hours spent on this grant: Ian 82, Jenn 32, Allyson 37= 151 hours X \$105/hr = \$15,855.00 spent. The grant is for \$24,236 so the remaining balance was \$8,381.00. This remaining balance was used to purchase nine CARB approved IQAir portable air filtration devices to be distributed to the community including schools.
