



## One of the states with the highest growth in Brazil


Official Growth Projection (Central Bank) – Regional Review: Mato Grosso is expected to record the highest GDP growth in Brazil in 2023, with an estimated increase of 6.1%. This projection exceeds that of all other Brazilian states.

## **AGROPOWER 70,7%**

The agriculture and livestock sector recorded the highest growth, with an increase of 70.7% compared to the same period in 2024.

## **INDUSTRY AT 6.7%**

The highest growth in industrial Gross Domestic Product (GDP) among all Brazilian states, with an estimated increase of 6.7%, according to Banco do Brasil's Regional Report.







## **PROGRAM SEAL**



### **SUPPORTING SEAL**

Issued in favor of the entity representing the class or collective segment, which carries out support campaigns for the "Carbono Neutro MT"

Program



### **COMMITMENT SEAL**

Individuals or legal entities that undertake a voluntary commitment to neutralize emissions by 2035



### **FINANCING SEAL**

Entity that finances public or private actions aimed at achieving the goal of neutralizing emissions in MT by 2035



## **CARBON 0% SEAL**

Granted to individuals or legal entities that demonstrate the achievement of the goal of neutralizing greenhouse gas emissions
