# Drive Forward: Light-duty Vehicle Program

#### **Background:**

 Governor's EO signed in June directs CARB action on new light-duty vehicle emission standards

#### Goals:

- Reduce emissions from light-duty vehicles to protect the health of all Californians
- Design stringent but flexible programs that achieve costeffective emission reductions
- Give incentives for early action
- Ensure real-world emission reductions



## Scope of the New Rulemaking

Evaluate tighter
PM and
NMOG+NOx
standards

Consider new non-exhaust PM emissions standards

Evaluate appropriate greenhouse gas standards

Explore further ways to address real-world emissions

Consider the role of ZEVs

Update ZEV certification requirements



## **Overview of First Workshop**

- Reducing smog-forming air pollutants like ozone and particulate matter
- Greenhouse gas and toxic emissions
- Engine certification requirements
- Zero-emission vehicle standards, and



# Innovative Small E-Fleet Pilot Project (ISEF)

## Background

- Reopened on October 21, 2025
- Provides fleets innovative solutions such as all-inclusive leases, truck-as-a-service, and other mechanisms
- Reduces the purchase price of zero-emission vehicles for small fleets
- Small fleet participants own 20 or fewer vehicles and make less than \$15 million in annual revenue
- Transactions have involved three primary parties ISEF Provider,
   HVIP approved dealer, and an eligible small fleet participant



## FY 2025-26 Recap









\$21 M Requested

53 unique fleets applied

Average fleet size: 4

73% domiciled in DAC

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

- From 2020-2025, CMEA has hosted 90 meetings and has had 500+ participants for 29 meetings/working groups held in 2025.








# **Annual Clean Mobility Forum Overview**

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# Community Planning & Capacity Building Grants: 2025 Request for Applications

- Open Now: Dec. 2, 2025 Applications due Feb. 10, 2026
- Funding: Up to \$500,000 per project, \$7.3M total available
- Who Can Apply: Tribal Governments, Community-Based Organizations, Local Governments, Public Schools
- Tribal Note: Waiver of sovereign immunity not required based on Tribal feedback
- Support: Request free <u>Technical Assistance</u> by Jan. 23, 2026
