Notice of Updates to the Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program Guidelines for Chapter 9

Lawn and Garden Equipment Replacement

Based on recommendations and comments from the public meeting process, the California Air Resources Board (CARB) is pleased to provide updates to the [Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program \(Carl Moyer Program\) Guidelines for Chapter 9: Lawn and Garden Equipment Replacement](#).

On November 14, 2022, staff released proposed updates to the Carl Moyer Program Guidelines Chapter 9: Lawn and Garden Equipment Replacement, for a 45-day public comment period. CARB Staff hosted a public meeting to discuss the proposed updates on November 30, 2022. The 45-day public comment period concluded on December 29, 2022.

As a result of these collaborative efforts, feedback received during the public meetings and the public comment period, and under the authority delegated to the Executive Officer by [Resolution 21-24](#), CARB staff are releasing the following summarized updates to the Carl Moyer Program's Chapter 9: Lawn and Garden Equipment Replacement to equitably support small fleets, small businesses, and communities with priority populations statewide in accelerating the transition to zero-emission lawn and garden equipment.

Carl Moyer Program Guidelines, Chapter 9: Lawn and Garden Equipment Replacement

Summary of Updates

- Applicant eligibility expanded beyond residential applicants.
- Equipment eligibility expanded beyond lawn mowers.
- Updated maximum funding amounts.
- Co-funding to facilitate funding with other funding sources such as the Clean Off-Road Equipment Voucher Incentive Project (CORE).

Staff published the proposed guideline updates for a 45-day public comment period and the details below reflect the comments received and changes made:

- Clarification on where to buy Moyer eligible equipment.
- Clarification on business participant requirements.
- Clarification on equipment ownership requirements.
