

**PERP – Form 6 – Electronic – Agreement**

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This Electronic Agreement authorizes the California Air Resources Board's (CARB) Portable Equipment Registration Program (PERP) to send PERP-related notifications and documents, including registration documents, electronically in lieu of written notifications. Any associated registration identification device (such as a registration sticker) and placard will be mailed separately.

This agreement also requires application submittals and notifications to be sent electronically instead of mailing documents through postal services.

**Complete and submit this Agreement in order to send and receive PERP-related applications and notifications, including registration documents, electronically instead of by conventional or hard-copy mail.**
