What is Cal Fleet Advisor?



Cal Fleet Advisor



- Administered by CALSTART on behalf of CARB
- Funded by HVIP
- Provide free Technical Assistance to all California MHD fleets
- Prioritize small fleets, drayage, and disadvantaged communities
- Collaborative approach to fleet assistance – learn about fleet needs and provide fleet-specific advice



Cal Fleet Advisor Mission



Cal Fleet Advisor's mission is to provide **no-cost education, technical assistance, and referrals** to enable **California's medium- and heavy-duty fleets** of **any size** to switch to **zero-emissions vehicles**.

How We Help

- **Provide** concierge-style assistance to help fleets overcome electrification challenges
- **Address** fleet's specific needs – not a one-size-fits-all approach
- **Focus** on straightforward solutions to stated issues
- **Apply** lessons to future fleet assistance



Who We Serve



- Any on-road medium- or heavy-duty commercial fleet in California
 - From cargo vans to semi-trucks
- Currently working with fleets from 0 trucks to 52,000
- Many different types of fleets:
 - Commercial fleets
 - Non-profits
 - Cities
 - Irrigation districts
 - Transit operators
 - School bus fleets
 - And more!

Benefits to Fleets



- **Gain** an understanding of how they can benefit from switching to ZEVs

How to Use CFA



1. **Fill out** the simple form at calfleetadvisor.org
2. **Talk** about your fleet's needs with your advisor
3. **Get recommendations** for vehicles, charging, and incentives
4. **Ask** for referrals to utilities, dealers, and project partners
5. **Get incentives** tailored to your fleet
6. **Start using your ZEVs and save on fuel, maintenance, and more!**

Introduction

- What is **Clean Fleet Connect**?
- Planned web tool to highlight medium- and heavy-duty on-road fleets that adopt zero-emission vehicles (ZEVs)
- Connect sustainability-minded organizations with zero-emission fleets
- Fleet participation is **voluntary**



Clean Fleet Connect Basics

Clean Fleet Connect would:

- Showcase voluntary early-action zero-emission fleets
- Improve visibility for participating fleets
- Support sustainability efforts

Clean Fleet Connect would **not**:

- Create regulatory requirements or affect compliance
- Provide guaranteed business or financial benefits
- Endorse or recommend any specific entity

Web Tool Concept

Public Web App

- Hosted on a dedicated webpage
- User-friendly, public list of participating fleets
 - Search and filter options
- Regular data updates

Displayed Fleet Information




- Contact information
- Company/agency name
- Percentage of fleet that is zero-emission
- Number of zero-emission vehicles in vehicle classes
- Vocation
- Region of service

Highlighted Fleet Characteristics

Fleets can voluntarily opt to be highlighted in the tool if they meet the following proposed thresholds:

- (1) Operate at least one zero-emission vehicle in California;
- (2) At least 5% of the California fleet is zero-emission;
- (3) The number of zero-emission vehicles in the California fleet meets or exceeds the ZEV Milestones;
- (4) The fleet owner maintains up to date reporting on their fleet

ZEV Milestones

| Zero-Emission Fleet Percentage | 10% | 25% | 50% | 75% | 100% |

| Group 1: Box trucks, vans, 2-axle buses, yard trucks, light-duty package delivery vehicles  | 2025 | 2028 | 2031 | 2033 | 2035 |
| Group 2: Work trucks, pickups, day cab tractors, 3-axle buses  | 2027 | 2030 | 2033 | 2036 | 2039 |
| Group 3: Sleeper cab tractors and Class 8 specialty vehicles  | 2030 | 2033 | 2036 | 2039 | 2042 |

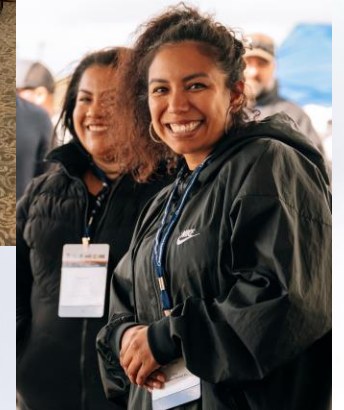

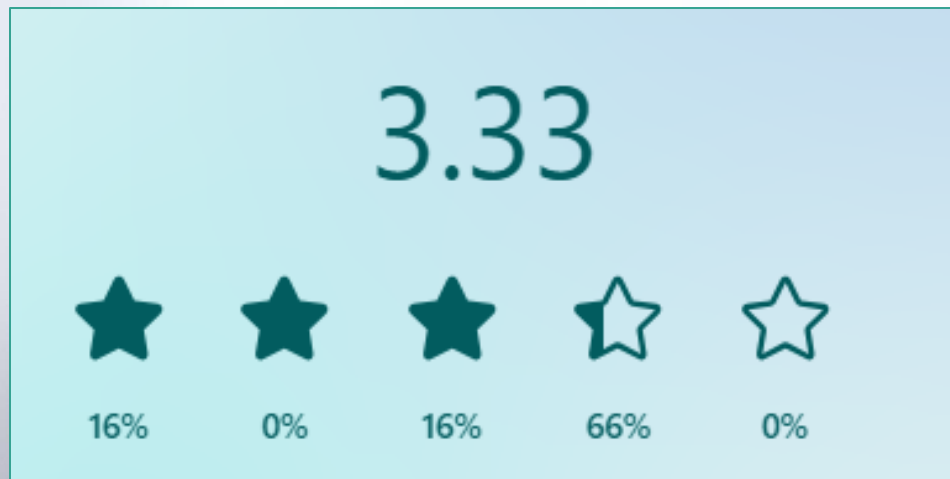

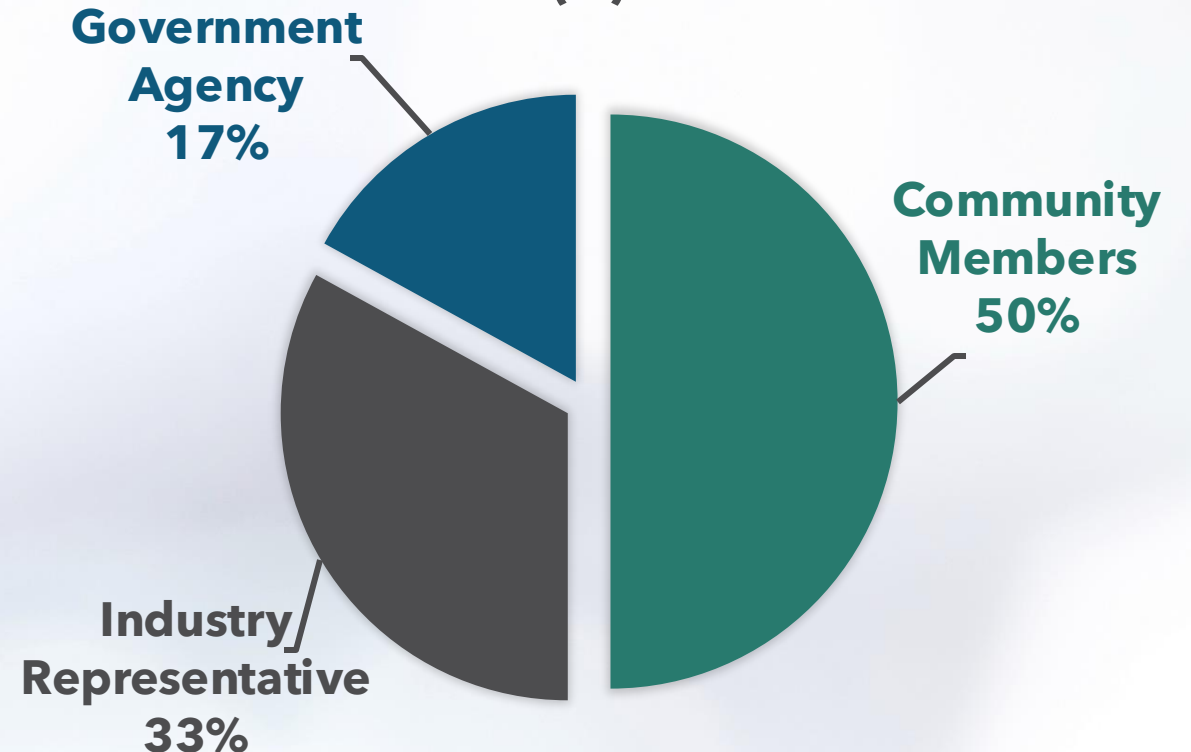
