Dear Sir or Madam,

We are pleased to announce that the California Air Resources Board (CARB) Draft 2023 Consumer & Commercial Products Survey Data (Draft 2023 Survey Data) and supplemental materials are now available for public review at: [2023 Consumer and Commercial Products Survey | California Air Resources Board](#). This detailed survey data will enhance our understanding of California consumer product emission characteristics as needed to effectively meet the State's air quality, climate, and community health goals.

Draft 2023 Survey Data is being published for the first time for stakeholder review and feedback. These materials provide a detailed summary of consumer product sales, emissions, volatile organic compound content, chemical speciation, reactivity, and other information for 37 categories of consumer products sold or supplied for use in California during calendar year 2023. In total, more than 600 product manufacturers and formulators participated in this effort, providing product sales and chemical formulation information for over 46,200 products sold in California.

Note that some information has been omitted. To protect confidentiality of responding companies, information has been withheld in cases when few products were reported within a particular category. In addition, the quantity of some reported chemical ingredients has been withheld from some tables to protect confidentiality. For more information regarding the information presented and methods used to protect confidentiality, see the "Format Overview and Explanation" document included in the data summaries.

CARB staff will hold a webinar to discuss the Draft Consumer Products Survey Data and supplemental materials with interested stakeholders in the near future.

We also look forward to meeting individually with interested stakeholders in the months ahead to discuss any questions or comments you may have.
