The County of Fresno requests that the California Air Resources Board (CARB) approve the South Central Fresno Community Emissions Reduction Program (CERP) as prepared by the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (Air District). Since 2018, the Air District has conducted numerous community and committee meetings, developed a robust air quality education program and media campaign, engaged local stakeholders and community advocates, and coordinated with both the City and County of Fresno to prepare and finalize the CERP.
