“Alternative 1” is urgently needed to convert the entire system of supermarkets and other large refrigerators to natural refrigerants with a GWP of 10 or less. Make it better by adding incentives or tax breaks for stores in disadvantaged areas.

Project Drawdown pointed out three years ago, refrigerant management can avoid 57.75 GIGATONS CO2 EQUIVALENT (2020–2050), more than any other single technological program for reducing or avoiding or capturing GHGs and it will cost a lot but this must be done urgently.

Please ALSO consider expecting goals for city and county Climate Action Plans to do what they can to help move this program faster. All people must be educated about the opportunities to reduce GHGs by refrigerant management.
