Governor's Initiatives

Proposed 2006-07 Budget

- New funding and positions for ARB
 - \$6.5M for hydrogen highway
 - \$5.2M, 14.8 PYs for climate change
 - \$4M, 19 PYs for enforcement/testing
 - \$2M for innovative clean air technologies
 - \$1.7M, 7.7 PYs for goods movement
 - \$1.1M for in-use diesel testing

Strategic Growth Plan

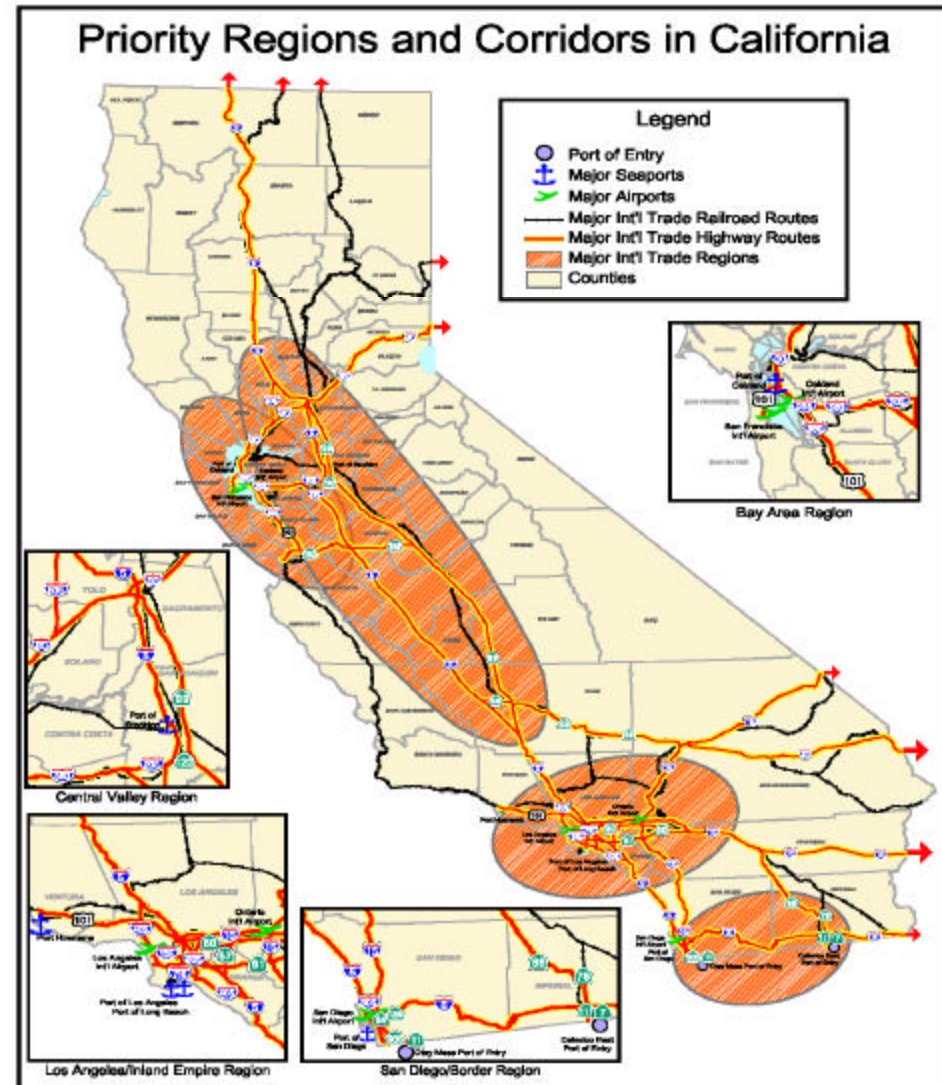
- “We need to consider clean air as part of our critical infrastructure.” *State of the State Address*
- Proposed \$1 billion in GO bonds (w/equal match) to cut goods movement air pollution

Goods Movement Action Plan

- Phase I report done
- Phase II July 2006
- ARB Comprehensive Emission Reductions Plan incorporated
- Tied back to bonds

Climate Action Team

- Targets set
- Strategies being defined
- Report to Gov mid-February
- ARB Board update in March

ARB Responsible for:

- ✓ Vehicle standards
- ✓ Idling limits

Hydrogen Highway Network

- Contracts to build first 3 State funded stations for public fueling
- Funding proposed for another 3 public stations and 5 demonstration buses

Diesel Risk Reduction

- On-road public and utility truck fleets
- Mfr in-use testing of trucks and buses
- Zero-emission buses
- Diesel control verification procedures
- Border trucks



Diesel Risk Reduction, cont.

- Off-road diesel equipment
- In-use stationary agricultural engines
- Portable equipment
- Commercial harbor craft
- Incineration on cargo ships

Other Major Activities

School Bus Guidelines

- \$25M this year
- Need to update guidelines
- Replace oldest buses first
- All areas eligible for retrofit \$

Passenger vehicles:

- Catalyst replacement specs
- Exhaust testing procedures
- On-board diagnostics review
- Initiate LEV/ZEV Expert Review



ARB Rulemakings

NOx/VOC Controls

Other sources:

- Forklifts and other large gas equipment
- Aboveground gasoline storage tanks
- Ethanol in reformulated gasoline
- Consumer products standards



ARB Rulemakings

Air Toxics

- Environmental tobacco smoke ID
- New requirements for chrome plating
- Tighter dry cleaning (perc) rules
- Formaldehyde controls
- Add diesel engines to “Hot Spots” emission reporting program

Nitrogen Dioxide Standard

- Review existing state standard
- Consider tighter standard to protect asthmatics

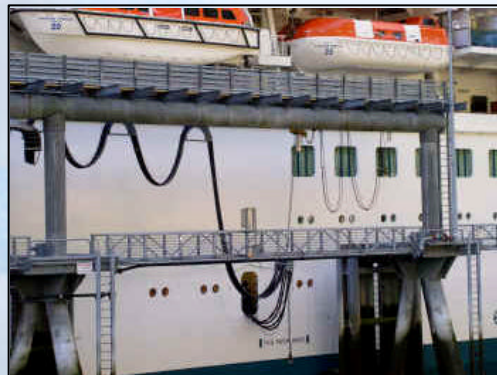

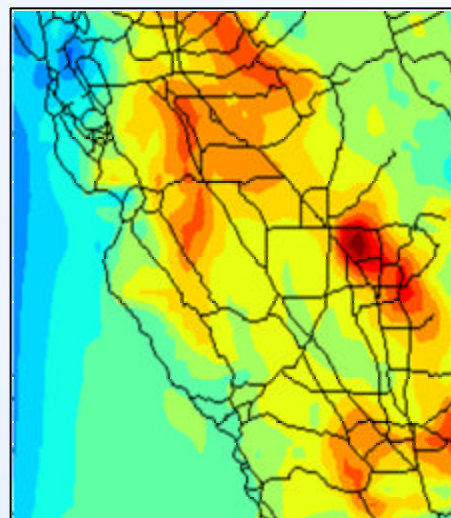
