



# California Public Utilities Commission Implementation of Clean Miles Standard

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# Commission Roles

- Implements annual GHG emission reduction targets and goals beginning in 2023, considering:
  - the impact on lower income drivers
  - sustainable land-use objectives of SB375
  - clean mobility goals for lower income individuals
- Separate effort to advance CMS goals in reviewing utility transportation electrification applications





# Procedural Steps

- Commission would issue “Order Instituting Rulemaking”
- Public comments solicited on the scope of proceeding
- Interested “parties” file comments
- Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) assigned

- Public “Prehearing Conference” held to discuss scope and schedule
- Assigned Commissioner issues “Scoping Memo” to schedule and define issues
- Comments on the scope of the issues are solicited in the rulemaking.

- Commission staff engage public via meetings, working groups, public workshops, etc.
- Public record may be developed through hearings and written comments from parties and Commission staff
- Proposed Decision issued on matters scoped in the proceeding
