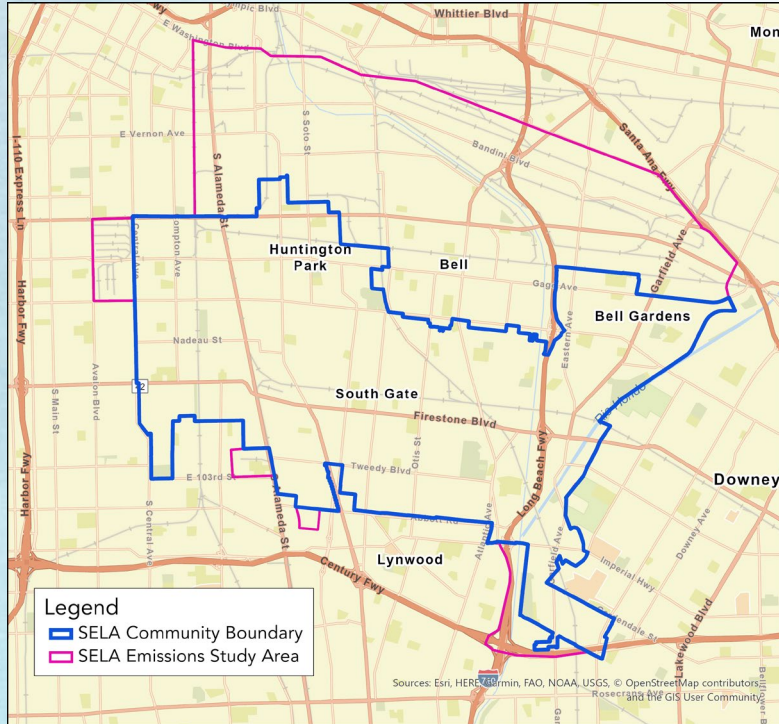




Consideration of the Southeast Los Angeles Community Emissions Reduction Program

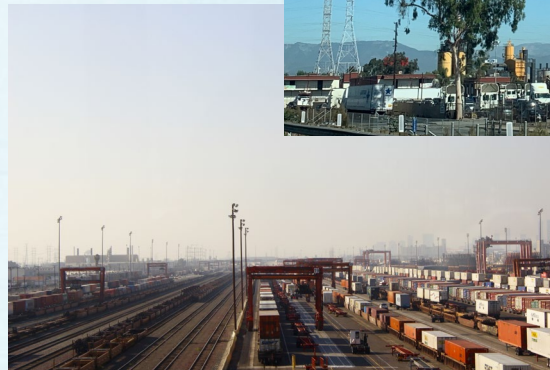
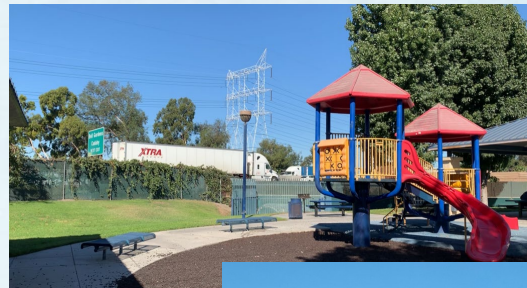
Establish a Community Pollution Enforcement Workgroup
