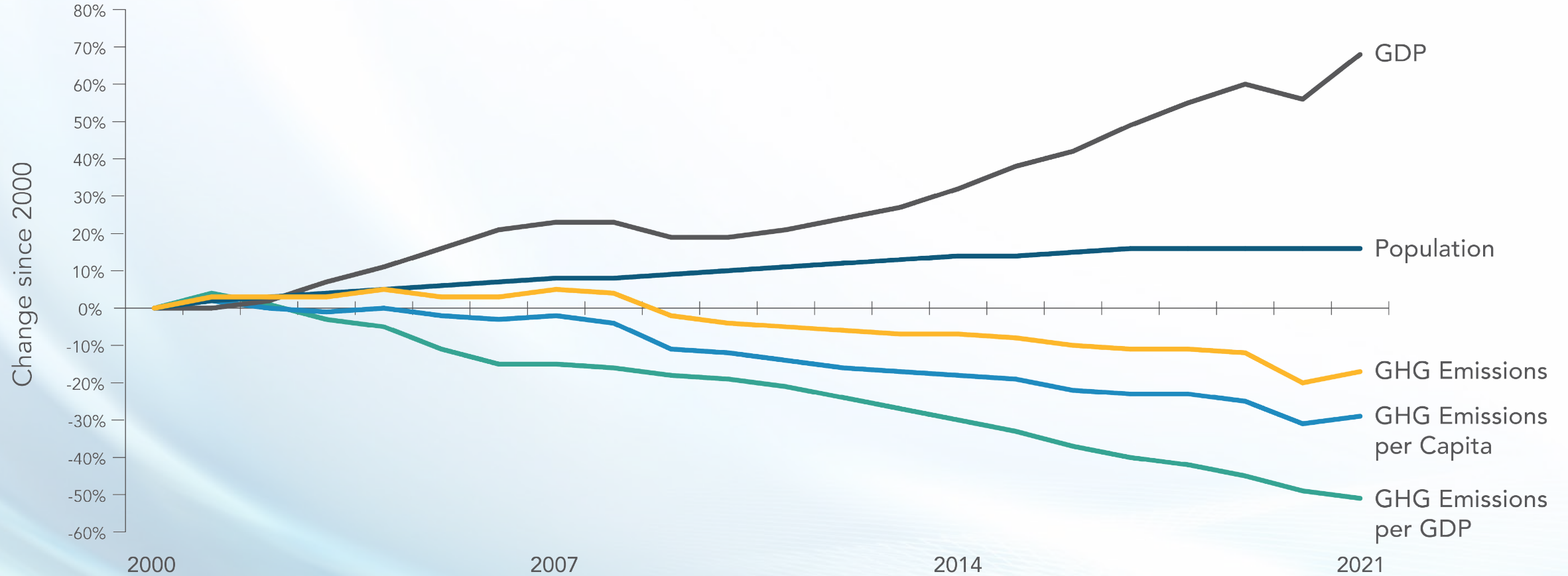

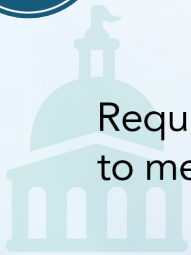

How cuts happen?

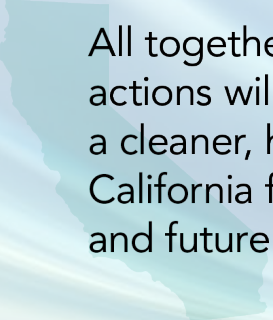
Zero emission cars, trucks and fuels



CARB rules that make that possible:
Advanced Clean Trucks, Advanced Clean Cars, Advanced Clean Fleets

- ACT: Reach 100% ZEV sales by 2035
- ACC II: 100% ZEV sales requirement by 2035
- ACF: Supports fleets reaching 100% zero emissions by 2040

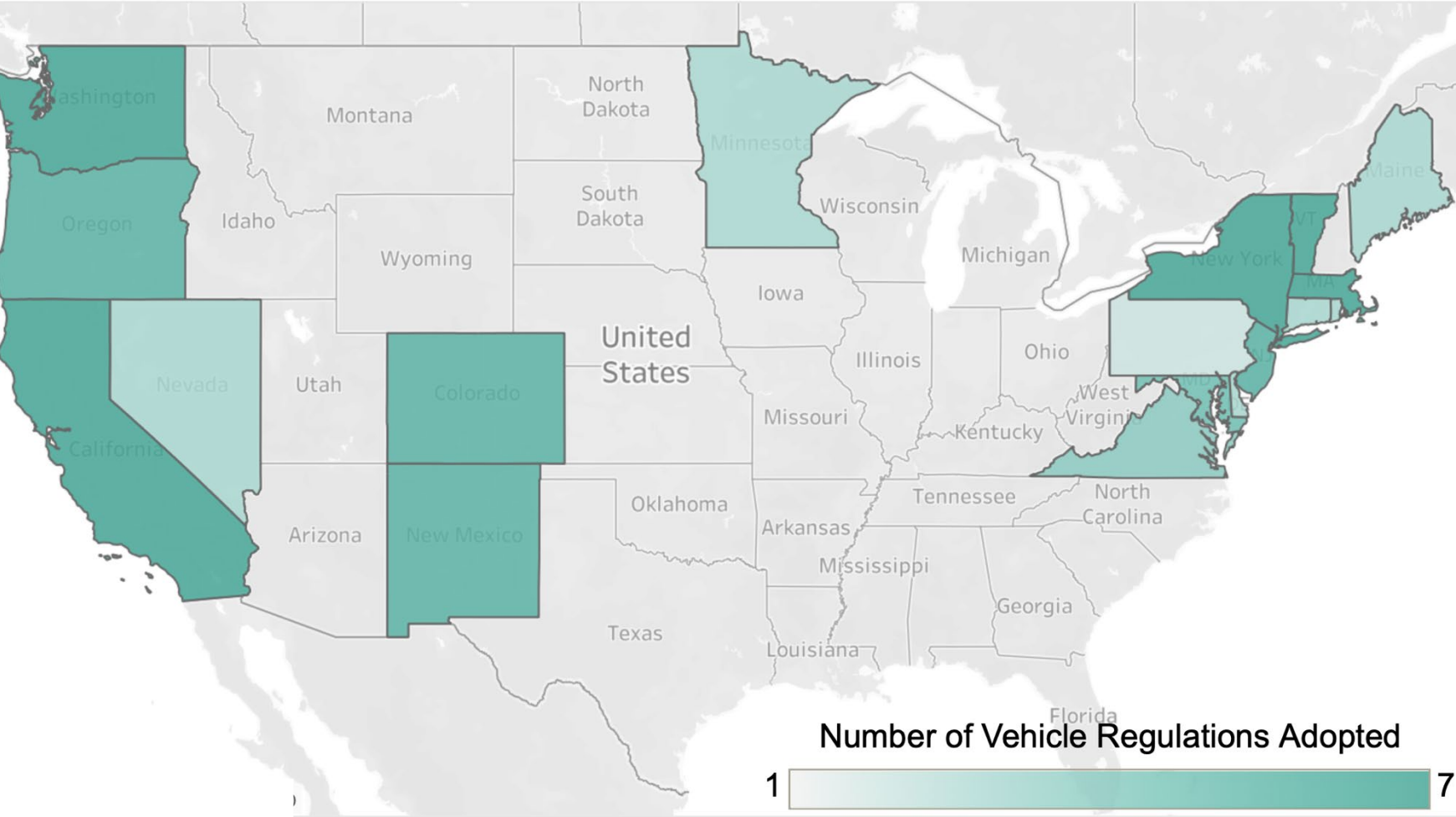
