

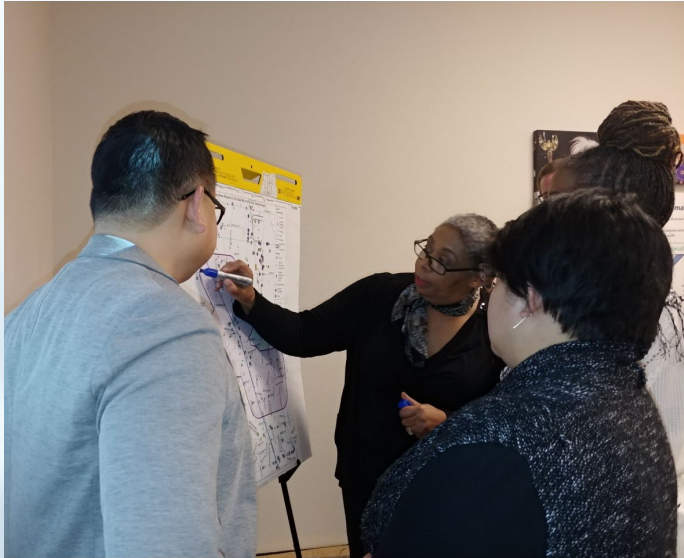

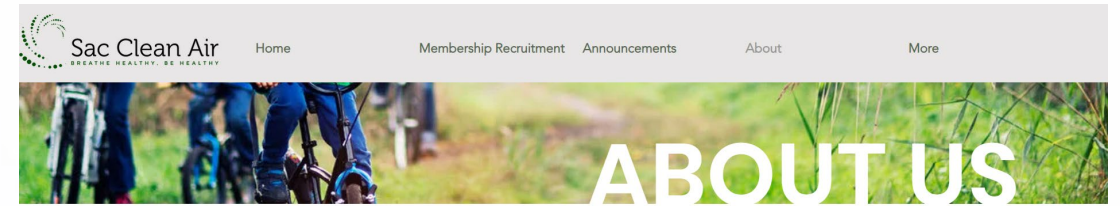


## Staff's Recommendation

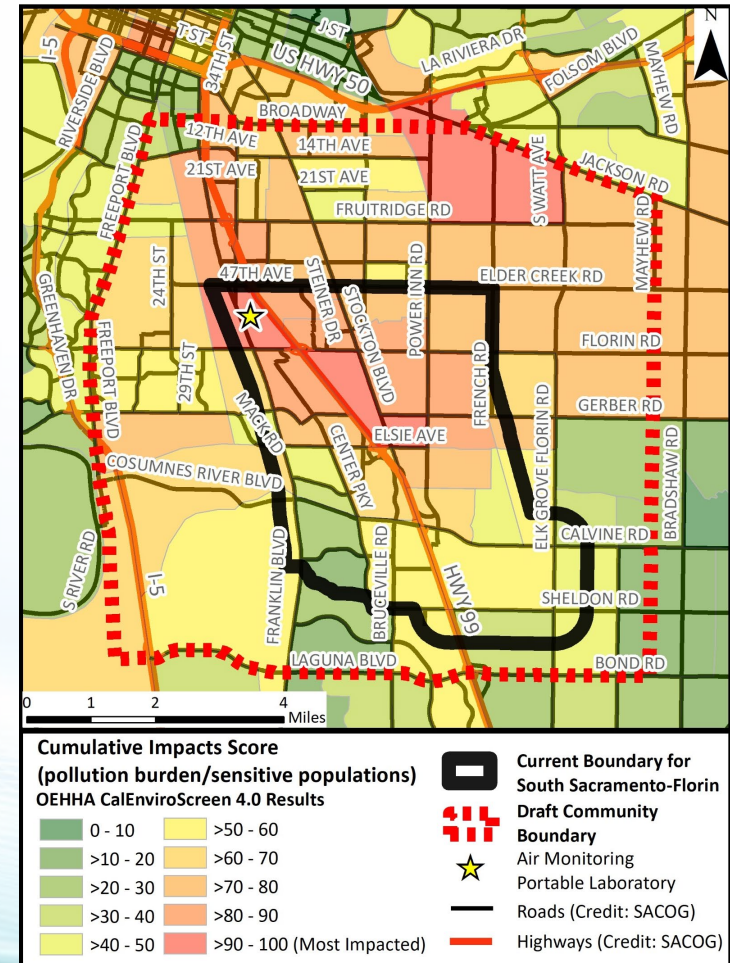
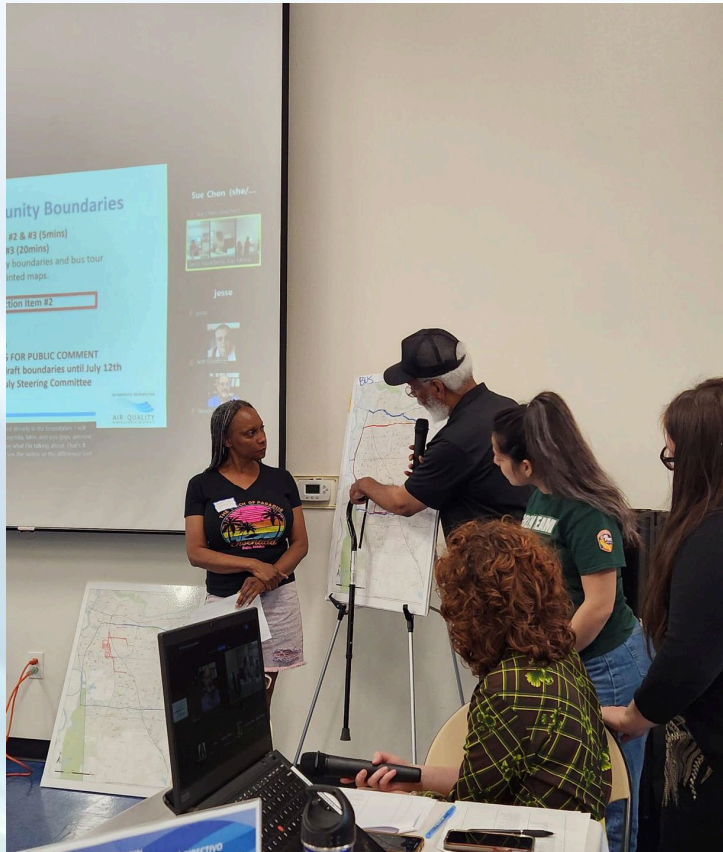
# South Sacramento-Florin Achievements

- Air District made real-time community-level air quality data readily accessible
- Community Steering Committee created a dedicated website to increase community engagement
- Multi-agency collaboration to organize community-wide air quality events
- Air District prioritizing early emission reductions in the community and surrounding area

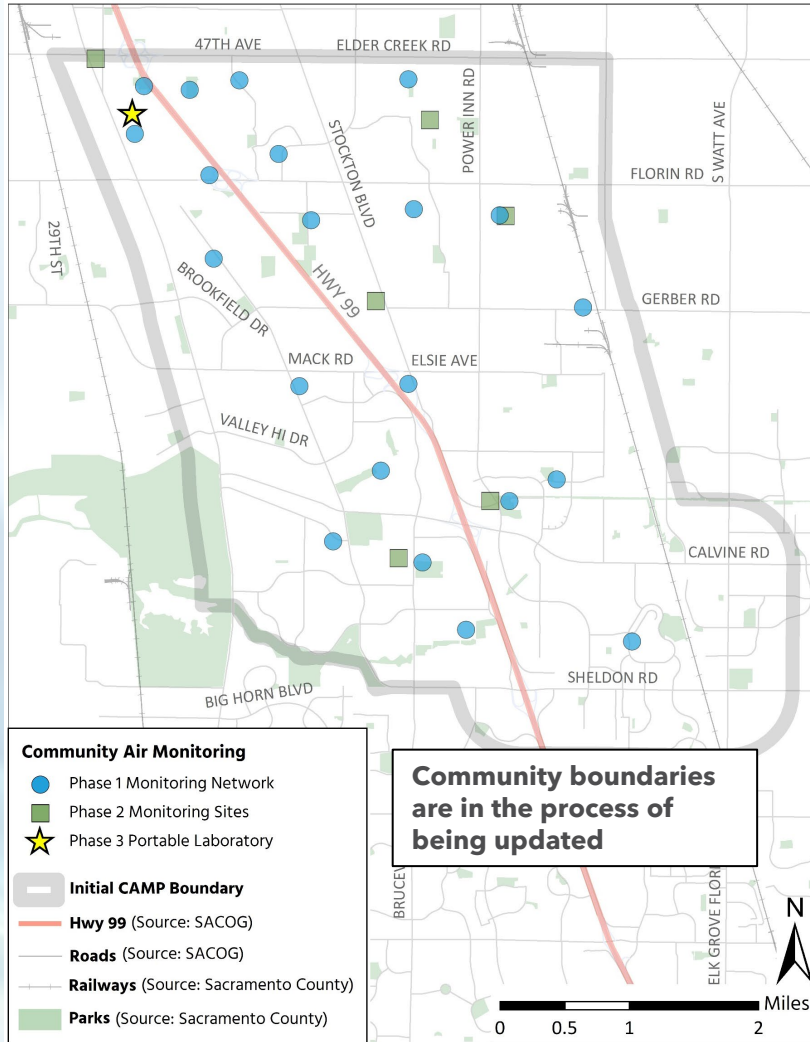


# Proposed New Community Boundary

# Community Air Monitoring Plan Implementation Continues



2019 - Deployment

## Phase 1:

Portable sensors to monitor PM<sub>2.5</sub>

Aug 2020 - Dec 2021

## Phase 2:

Black Carbon, speciated PM<sub>2.5</sub>, PM<sub>10</sub>, VOCs

July 2020

**Air District submitted the CAMP to CARB**

Apr 2023 - TBD

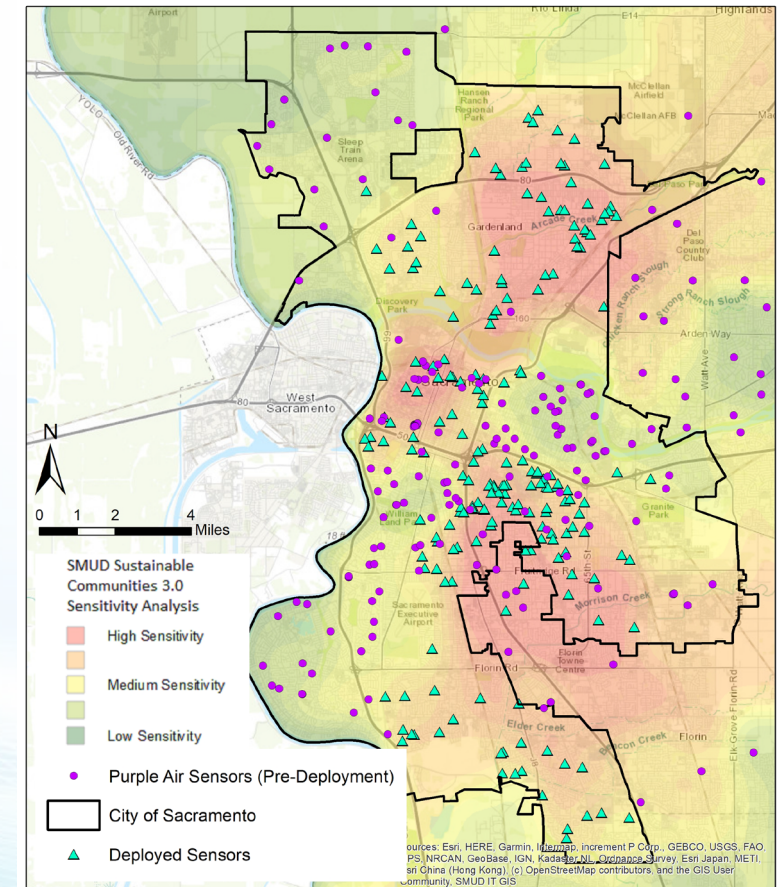
## Phase 3:

Portable lab monitoring with regulatory-grade equipment

- Sacramento County Vehicle Emissions Project (VEP)
- Community Air Grant to Valley Vision for Sacramento Neighborhoods Activating on Air Quality Project
- US EPA grant to United Latinos



# Partnerships to Benefit Sacramento Communities

- Reduce emissions in many more communities
- Focus on clean energy transition and prosperity goals to benefit communities across the region
- Prioritize air and climate investments in under-resourced communities
  - ZEV Deployment Strategy developed by the Air District, SacRT, SACOG, SMUD
