WHEREAS, a solicited proposal, Number 94-10-01, entitled, "Clean Air Two-Stroke (CATS) for Utility Engine Applications", has been submitted by BKM, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the proposal has been independently reviewed for technical and business merit by highly qualified university professors; and

WHEREAS, the Research, Stationary Source, and Mobile Source Division staff and the Executive Officer have reviewed and recommend for funding:

Proposal Number 94-10-01, entitled, "Clean Air Two-Stroke (CATS) for Utility Engine Applications", submitted by BKM, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$199,491.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Air Resources Board, pursuant to the authority granted by the Health and Safety Code Section 39703, hereby accepts the recommendation and approves the following:
