WHEREAS, the Research Division staff has reviewed and recommended this proposal for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Research Screening Committee has reviewed and recommends for funding:

Proposal Number 2198-189, entitled "Demonstration of a Heavy-Duty Vehicle Chassis Screening Test for Compliance Testing Heavy-Duty Engines", submitted by the University of West Virginia, for an amount not to exceed \$289,518.
