WHEREAS, she has been an early and strongly principled advocate of public/private partnership, linking government with private industry on projects for their mutual benefit;





WHEREAS, after 30 years of public service with government agencies in Southern California, Harriett has retired from her position as Orange County Supervisor and will be leaving the Board.


