WHEREAS, a proposal, Number 96-01-11 entitled "Application Demonstration for Dual Stage Biofilter for Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW's)," has been submitted by the Reynolds Group, in response to Request for Proposals Number 96-01; and

WHEREAS, the proposal has been independently reviewed for technical and business merit by highly qualified individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Research Division staff, the Deputy Executive Officers, and the Executive Officer have reviewed and recommend for funding:

Proposal Number 96-01-11, entitled "Application Demonstration for Dual Stage Biofilter for Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW's)," submitted by the Reynolds Group, for a total amount not to exceed \$142,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Air Resources Board, pursuant to the authority granted by Health and Safety Code Section 39703, hereby accepts the recommendation of staff and approves the following:

Proposal Number 96-01-11, entitled "Application Demonstration for Dual Stage Biofilter for Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW's)," submitted by the Reynolds Group, for a total amount not to exceed \$142,500.
