**WHEREAS**, the Research Division staff have reviewed and recommended this proposal for approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the Research Screening Committee has reviewed and recommends for funding:

Proposal Number 2392-206 entitled "Investigation of Low Reactivity Solvents for Use in Consumer Products", submitted by the California State Polytechnic University, San Luis Obispo, for a total amount not to exceed \$84,315.
