Executive Order R-11-004

Relating to Regulation for Energy Efficiency and Co-Benefits Assessment of Large Industrial Facilities

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2010, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed adoption of the Energy Efficiency and Co-Benefits Assessment of Large Industrial Facilities, as set forth in the Initial Statement of Reasons released to the public on June 2, 2010;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 10-30, in which the Board approved sections 95600, 95601, 95602, 95603, 95604, 95605, 95606, 95607, 95608, 95609, 95610, 95611, and 95612, title 17, California Code of Regulations, as set forth in Attachment B thereto;

WHEREAS, Resolution 10-30 directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulations, after making the modified regulatory language available for public comment for a period of 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, shall make such modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2010, the approved regulations, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, have been made available for public comment for a period of 15 days in accordance with the provisions of title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44; and

WHEREAS, no written comments were received during the15 day comment period;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 10-30 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that sections 95600, 95601, 95602, 95603, 95604, 95605, 95606, 95607, 95608, 95609, 95610, 95611, and 95612, title17, California Code of Regulations, is approved and adopted as set forth in Attachment 1 to this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the adopted regulatory text may be further revised with nonsubstantial or grammatical changes, which will be added to the rulemaking record and indicated as such.
