Project Description: Staff proposed fuel pathways for inclusion in the Low Carbon Fuel Standard regulation. These proposed new pathways include four that staff developed and eight that biofuel producers have submitted pursuant to the requirements of the regulation. The hearing was conducted by the Executive Officer.
