Notice of Public Availability of Modified Text

PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER AMENDMENTS TO THE LEV III CRITERIA POLLUTANT REQUIREMENTS FOR LIGHT- AND MEDIUM-DUTY VEHICLES, THE HYBRID ELECTRIC VEHICLE TEST PROCEDURES, AND THE HEAVY-DUTY OTTO-CYCLE AND HEAVY-DUTY DIESEL TEST PROCEDURES

Public Hearing Date: October 23, 2014 Public Availability Date: December 23, 2014 Deadline for Public Comment: January 12, 2015

At its October 23, 2014, public hearing, the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) approved for adoption in Resolution 14-34 amendments to sections 1900, 1956.8, 1961.2, 1962.2, 1965, 1976, and 1978, Title 13, California Code of Regulations and modifications to the documents incorporated by reference therein. The amendments incorporate elements of the federal Tier 3 program that are more stringent than LEV III or provide additional compliance flexibility without reducing or delaying progress towards achieving the benefits of LEV III.

At the hearing, the staff presented, and the Board approved for adoption, additional modified regulatory language and additional modifications to some of the incorporated test procedures, as presented in Attachment K to Board Resolution 14-34. The additional modifications include a number of changes to the original proposed amendments made in response to comments received after the Staff Report was published, and other modifications needed to correct errors in the original proposal. These modifications also include changes to the incorporated sections of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) to align with recent updates to the CFR published after the release of the Staff Report, clarifying changes and corrections to the dates of applicability for medium-duty LEV II categories and Supplemental Federal Test Procedure interim in-use compliance emission standards. Not all of the test procedures that included changes as part of the original amendments include additional changes as part of this 15-day notice; only the incorporated documents that include changes as part of this notice are included in Enclosure A.

The Board directed the Executive Officer to make the modified regulatory language, and any additional conforming modifications, available for public comment, with any additional supporting documents and information, for a period of at least 15 days as required by Government Code section 11346.8. The Board further directed the Executive Officer to consider written comments submitted during the public review period and make any further modifications that are appropriate available for public comment for at least 15 days, and take final action to adopt the amendments after addressing all appropriate modifications, or present the amendments to the Board for

further consideration if warranted.

The text of the modified regulatory language is shown in Enclosure A. The originally proposed regulatory language is shown in strikethrough to indicate deletions and underline to indicate additions. New deletions and additions to the proposed language that are made public with this notice are shown in double strikethrough and double underline format, respectively. Those sections of the regulations and test procedures that contain originally proposed changes, but do not include 15-day changes are not included in Enclosure A. The justifications for all of the changes in Enclosure A are shown in Enclosure B.

In the Final Statement of Reasons, staff will respond to all comments received on the record during the comment periods. The Administrative Procedure Act requires that staff respond to comments received regarding all changes that are noticed. Therefore, staff will only address comments that are responsive to this notice, documents added to the record, or the changes detailed in Enclosure A.

These modifications do not change implementation of the regulation in any way that affects the conclusions of the environmental analysis included in the Staff Report because the modifications are primarily administrative, clarifying changes, corrections of errors, and technical corrections that do not alter the compliance responses, so no additional environmental analysis or recirculation of that analysis is required.
