# Third Notice of Public Availability of Modified Text and Availability of Additional Documents

#### PROPOSED RE-ADOPTION OF THE LOW CARBON FUEL STANDARD

Public Hearing Date: February 19, 2015
First Public Availability Date: June 4, 2015
Deadline for First Public Comment: June 19, 2015
Second Public Availability Date: June 23, 2015
Deadline for Second Public Comment: July 8, 2015

At its February 19, 2015, public hearing the Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) considered staff's proposed sections 95480, 95481, 95482, 95483, 95483.1, 95483.2, 95484, 95485, 95486, 95487, 95488, 95489, 95490, 95491, 95492, 95493, 95494, 95495, 95496, and 95497, Title 17, California Code of Regulations (CCR) to reduce the carbon intensity (CI) of transportation fuels used in California by at least 10 percent by the year 2020. In addition to substantially reducing greenhouse gas emissions from transportation fuels, the Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) is expected to help diversify the transportation fuels market in California, thereby cutting petroleum dependency and creating a sustainable and growing market for cleaner fuels. The proposed action includes repeal of the existing LCFS regulation (CCR, title 17, sections 95480-95490) in its entirety.

The Board directed the Executive Officer to determine if additional conforming modifications to the regulation were appropriate and to make any proposed modified regulatory language available for public comment, with any additional supporting documents and information, for a period of at least 15 days in accordance with Government Code section 11346.8. The Board further directed the Executive Officer to consider written comments submitted during the public review period and make any further modifications that are appropriate available for public comment for at least 15 days. The Executive Officer was directed to evaluate all comments received during the public comment periods, including comments raising significant environmental issues, and prepare written responses to such comments as required by ARB's certified regulations at California Code of Regulations, title 17, sections 60000-60007 and Government Code section 11346.9(a). The Executive Officer was further directed to present to the Board, at a subsequently scheduled public hearing, staff's written responses to environmental comments and the final environmental analysis for consideration for approval, along with the final regulation for consideration for adoption.

The text of the modified regulatory language is shown in Attachment A. The originally proposed regulatory language is shown in strikethrough to indicate deletions. In the originally proposed regulatory language, regular text indicates additions for readability. Deletions and additions to the proposed language that were made public with the June 4<sup>th</sup> Notice are shown in deuble strikethrough and double underline format, respectively. Deletions and additions to the proposed language that were made public with the June 23<sup>rd</sup> Notice are shown in beld double strikethrough and bold double underline format, respectively. Deletions and additions to the proposed language that are made public for comment with this notice are shown in italicized bold double strikethrough and italicized bold double underline format, respectively.

In the Final Statement of Reasons, staff will respond to comments received on the record during the comment periods. The Administrative Procedure Act requires that staff respond to comments received regarding all changes that are noticed. Therefore, staff will address only comments received during this 15-day comment period that are responsive to this notice, documents added to the record with this notice, or the changes detailed in Attachment A.

The following summary does not include all modifications to correct typographical or grammatical errors, changes in numbering or formatting, or non-substantive revisions made to improve clarity. For a complete account of all modifications in the proposed regulation, please refer to Attachment A.

## **Summary of Proposed Modifications**

To make the proposed regulation more clear, staff is proposing the following changes, none of which is intended to substantively change the proposal.

- In section 95486(a)(2), staff is proposing to remove the sentence stating that
  provisional credits may not be used until they are fully recognized. That
  sentence is not needed given the sentence that follows, and could create
  confusion.
- 2. In section 95488(a)(1), staff is proposing to strike subsection (C) because it duplicates subsection (B).
- 3. In section 95489(a), staff is proposing to add a brief description of added subsection 95489(g) to be consistent with the rest of the section 95489(a) which briefly describes subsections (b) through (f).

## Additional Document(s) Added to the Record

A stakeholder has requested the information below. In the interests of fairness and transparency, ARB is choosing to make this information available to all stakeholders and the general public and to allow public comment on this information.
