Background

Government Code section [14516](#) directs the Board, Commission, and Department to meet at least twice per calendar year to coordinate their implementation of policies that jointly affect transportation, housing, and air quality, including interagency efforts.

Presentations will facilitate open dialogue amongst state agencies and the public. We encourage public participation and there will be dedicated time allotted for public comments.

This joint meeting is separate from CARB's other separately scheduled November Board Meeting.
