EXECUTIVE ORDER R-07-002

Relating to the Amendments of California Regulations for the Motor Vehicle Service Information Rule

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2006, the Air Resources Board (the Board or ARB) conducted a public hearing to consider Amendments of California Regulations for Motor Vehicle Service Information, as set forth in the Initial Statement of Reasons released to the public on May 5, 2006;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing on June 22, 2006, the Board adopted Resolution 06-19, in which the Board approved amendments of section 1969, title 13, California Code of Regulations (CCR), and sections 60060.2, 60060.11, 60060.15, 60060.16, 60060.17, 60060.18, 60060.22, 60060.29, 60060.32, 60060.33, and 60060.34, title 17, CCR, as set forth in Attachment A and B and modified by Attachment C;

WHEREAS, Resolution 06-19 directed the Executive Officer to take final action to adopt the regulatory amendments set forth in Attachment A, Attachment B, and Attachment C, with such other conforming modifications as may be appropriate, to make the modified regulatory language and any additional supporting documents and information available to the public for a period of at least 15 days, to consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, and to make such modifications as may be appropriate in light of the comments received, or to present the regulatory amendments to the Board for further consideration if she determines that this is warranted;

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2006, the modified regulations, reflecting the amendments approved by the Board and other changes made to best reflect the intent of the Board at the hearing, were made available for public comment for a period of at least 15 days, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44;

WHEREAS, one written comment was received during the 15-day comment period and that comment, as well as the comments received during the 45-day comment period, have been considered by the Executive Officer;

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer finds that the reporting requirements of this regulation which apply to businesses are necessary for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 06-19 are incorporated herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, in accordance with Resolution 06-19, that the amendments to section 1969, title 13, CCR, and sections 60060.2, 60060.11, 60060.15, 60060.16, 60060.17, 60060.18, 60060.22, 60060.29, 60060.32, 60060.33, and 60060.34, title 17, CCR, are hereby adopted as set forth in Attachment 1 hereto.
