## State of California AIR RESOURCES BOARD

## Executive Order G-98-065

WHEREAS, on April 23, 1998, the Air Resources Board (the Board or ARB) conducted a public hearing to consider the adoption of a regulation establishing a Minor Violation Program as required by sections 39150-39153 of the Health and Safety Code;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing on April 23, 1998, the Board adopted Resolution 98-18, in which the Board approved the regulatory amendments set forth in Attachment A thereto, which included staff's proposed modifications to the regulatory text set forth in Appendix A the Staff Report (released March 6, 1998);

WHEREAS, Attachment A to Resolution 98-18 contained new sections 60090 through 60094, of title 17, California Code of Regulations, as originally proposed by staff in Appendix A to the Staff Report and staff's proposed modifications to those sections;

WHEREAS, Resolution 98-18, the Board directed the Executive Officer to adopt the regulation as modified after making the modified regulatory language available to the public for a period of at least 15 days, provided that the Executive Officer shall consider such written comments as may be submitted during this period, and shall make modifications as appropriate in light of the comments received, and shall present the regulations to the Board for further consideration if he determines that this is warranted after review of the comments;

WHEREAS, the Board-approved modifications to the originally proposed text were made available for a public comment period of 15 days, in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44, with the modifications to the originally proposed text clearly indicated; and

WHEREAS, one written comment was received during the 15-day comment period, and after review, the Executive Officer has determined that reconsideration by the Board or modification of the approved regulation is not appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, that the recitals and findings in Resolution 98-18 are incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, in accordance with Resolution 98-18 and Health and Safety Code section 39515 and 39516, that new sections 60090 through 60094, title 17, California Code of Regulations, are hereby adopted as set forth in Attachment 2 hereto.
