### NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING TO CONSIDER A REPORT ON PROGRESS TOWARDS THE APRIL 2009 DEADLINE FOR ENHANCED VAPOR RECOVERY PHASE II SYSTEMS

The Air Resources Board (Board or ARB) will conduct a public meeting at the time and place noted below to consider a staff update on the implementation of the Enhanced Vapor Recovery (EVR) program, including progress towards meeting the April 1, 2009, deadline for installation of EVR Phase II systems.

This item will be considered at a two-day meeting of the Board, which will commence at 9:00 a.m., June 26, 2008, and may continue at 8:30 a.m., June 27, 2008. This item may not be considered until June 27, 2008. Please consult the agenda for the meeting, which will be available at least 10 days before June 26, 2008, to determine the day on which this item will be considered.

The EVR program requires gasoline dispensing facilities (GDF) to upgrade vapor recovery equipment to meet several technology-forcing standards. The EVR requirements are being phased in from 2001 to 2010. The next EVR upgrade for Phase II vapor recovery, which affects approximately 12,000 GDFs, must be completed by April 1, 2009. Several GDF operators and gasoline marketers' associations have requested an extension of the April 2009 compliance date. In response to the requested extension, ARB staff has determined that sufficient EVR equipment and contractors are available to meet the deadline and has recommended that the deadline be maintained.

The ARB staff's written findings are presented in a report: "Progress Towards April 2009 Deadline for Enhanced Vapor Recovery Phase II Systems." Copies of the report

At the Board meeting, ARB staff will summarize the written report's findings in an oral presentation to the Board.
