AIR RESOURCES BOARD

Executive Order G-99-048

WHEREAS, on August 27, 1998, the Air Resources Board (the "Board") conducted a public hearing to consider the amendment and adoption of regulations regarding stationary source test methods;

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Board adopted Resolution 98-38, in which the Board approved the amendment of Title 17, California Code of Regulations, sections 94101, 94102, 94117, 94103, 94104, 94118, 94119, 94106, 94108, 94109, 94110, 94120, 94121, 94122, 94111, 94112, 94113, 94137, 94123 and 94124, and the amendment and adoption of the incorporated test methods for stationary sources, Methods 1, 2, 2A, 3, 4, 5A, 5E, 6, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13A, 13B, 15, 16, 16A, 17, 20 and 21 respectively, as set forth in Attachments 1 and 2 thereto;

WHEREAS, the approved regulations were made available for public comment for a period of 15 days, with the changes to the originally proposed text clearly indicated, in accordance with the provisions of Title 1, California Code of Regulations, section 44; and

WHEREAS, no written comments were received during this 15-day comment period.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the recitals and findings contained in Resolution 98-38 are incorporated by reference herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, in accordance with Resolution 98-38 and Health and Safety Code sections 39601 and 39607(d), that sections 94101, 94102, 94117, 94103, 94104, 94118, 94119, 94106, 94108, 94109, 94110, 94120, 94121, 94122, 94111, 94112, 94113, 94137, 94123 and 94124 are amended, and the incorporated test methods for stationary sources, Methods 1, 2, 2A, 3, 4, 5A, 5E, 6, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13A, 13B, 15, 16, 16A, 17, 20 and 21 are amended and adopted respectively, as set forth in Attachment A hereto.
