

Small Fleets (1 to 3 trucks) Can Apply Now for Prop. 1B Grants

On July 25, 2013, the Board approved funding awards to eligible local and State agencies for FY2013-14 (Year 4) funds. The local agencies are currently conducting a second solicitation to receive applications from truck owners, with the following conditions:

- **All applicants must meet the eligibility requirements.** Basic requirements are:
 - 75% operation within California for the past 2 years
 - Move goods as part of a sales transaction
 - Commit to at least 50% travel within the four California trade corridors
 - Drayage trucks (including dray-off trucks) are not eligible
- **Small fleets will be given priority.** Large fleets may also apply during this solicitation.
- We are expanding this solicitation to allow funding for all engine model years that are **2006 and older.**

If small fleets meet the Proposition 1B goods movement eligibility requirements, they can now apply for a grant that would enable them to receive funding in 2014, and demonstrate a good faith effort to comply with the Truck and Bus Regulation. ARB has issued a Regulatory Advisory (Advisory) that provides guidance for fleets that make good faith efforts to comply with the Truck and Bus Regulation deadline.
