



The PBP recommended strategies include:

Evolution

"The state must establish a plan to eliminate air pollution disparities for all California communities by 2030" (pg.51) "Impacted communities must be full partners in all actions to address environmental justice" (pg.51) "The air pollution control sector of California must be trained, prepared, and energized to engage with impacted communities" (pg.51) "Systems approaches that transcend the silos of air, water, land, and materials should replace the state's current approach to remediation" (pg.51)
