Altair Paramount, LLC ("the Company") provides this response to the comment of the above referenced Commenter.

Section 95488.7(d)(5)(A) of the Low Carbon Fuel Standard Regulation states: "Only comments related to potential factual or methodological errors will require responses from the fuel pathway applicant." The comments received are neither factual nor methodological errors in the Company's fuel pathway application.

However, the company wishes to address the comments related to its pathway application as a participant in the LCFS program to the extent we possess direct knowledge of the answers.

If the comments on waste oil are regarding Used Cooking Oil (UCO), it is delivered by our suppliers, and they would be responsible for any spillage or accident handling on the way to the facility. UCO handled within the facility is controlled in spill containment areas and there are operational, health and safety procedures and processes in place.

The comments regarding the processing waste oil into a fuel at the generation site is not relevant to this pathway application and outside the scope of the pathway application. Similarly, the reference to the Kellogg fertilizer plant near the Carson Sewage Treatment facility has no relevance to this application.

Altair Paramount LLC appreciates the opportunity to respond to this comment. We reiterate our belief that no changes to the company's pathway application are required by these comments, and respectfully request that CARB certify the fuel pathways listed in Application No. B0592.
