ADF Regulatory Concepts White Paper, Alternative Diesel Fuel Rulemaking

Dear Mr. Mitchell:

We are writing on behalf of BioFuel Oasis in Berkeley, California to state our support for the comments included in the joint letter written by the California Biodiesel Alliance and the National Biodiesel Board.

BioFuel Oasis is a B100 biodiesel user group founded in 2003 to provide greater access to locally made biodiesel made from recycled waste vegetable oil. Over the past 10 years we have signed up over 3600 members to our "fleet". We were the first biodiesel fueling station to open in California and are still one of few public pumps where B100 is available. We are a women/worker-owned & operated cooperative that values sustainability, local production and community.

As a biodiesel retailer, our business would be devastated by NOX mitigations. A significant price increase would cause many of our customers to switch back to using lower-priced petroleum diesel, and would reverse any positive impacts on air quality that our sustainability-focused fueling station has made.
