Project Summary:

The solicitation was open from February 15, 2019 to March 15, 2019 and was available to, federal, State, or local government entities or agencies, and California nonprofit organizations. One application was received from Western States Trucking Association (WSTA) and a technical subcontractor, CleanFleets. WSTA represents and provides services to small trucking companies. CleanFleets is a consulting company who assists CARB regulated companies.

WSTA proposes to work closely with CARB, ESW CleanTech, and stakeholders to finalize the eligibility criteria and application procedure in the Program Implementation Manual through a public workgroup process. An application tracking system will be developed and requests for new PM filter systems and disbursements would be reviewed consistent with the Implementation Manual.
