


## PG&E's FleetReady Program Proposal



- PG&E's proposed FleetReady program would help electrify medium- and heavy-duty vehicle fleets through utility-funded "make-ready" charging infrastructure:
- If approved, PG&E covers costs for EV infrastructure up to the charger including new service, electric panel, trenching, conduit, and design, permitting, and construction costs.
- Fleet operator would be responsible for procurement of vehicles and chargers
  - Program includes additional incentives to help with charger purchase for transit & school buses, and sites supporting disadvantaged communities
- Program is currently under review by the CPUC. If approved, anticipated to launch in 2019
