

SAN & GHG Emissions

2006: AB32 Global Warming Solutions Act

- 1990 levels by 2020 goal

2008: Attorney General MOU

- GHG reduction commitments

2009: SAN Air Quality Management Plan

2010: SAN GT Conversion Incentive Program

2012: Taxi fleet begins converting to hybrids

2016: Airport Carbon Accreditation Program

- SAN certified at Level 2







Vehicle Conversion Incentive Program

- Goal: 100% conversion to Alternative Fuel
 Vehicles by 2017
- Applies to all public commercial ground transportation providers (except Limousines)
- Requirements:
 - Standardized Age Replacement
 - Hotel-Motel Shuttle Consolidation Incentive
 - Conversion Discount
 - Non-Conversion Premium



Hotel/Motel Shuttle Consolidation

 If a hotel/motel elects to utilize an AFV or CAV and consolidates its shuttle services with one or more hotel or motel:

Operators	Reduction in fees and charges		
2 to 3	50%		
4 to 5	75%		
6 plus	100%		

 The discounted rate would only apply to the dedicated AFVs or CAVs providing the courtesy service to the airport
