SUBJECT: NEW FUNDING CRITERIA FOR YEARS 16-18 CARL MOYER
PROGRAM MULTIDISTRICT GRANT FUNDS

This Mail-Out describes new funding criteria for the Years 16-18 Carl Moyer Program Multidistrict Grant Agreements. As part of the Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program, the California Air Resources Board (CARB or Board) has set aside funding for multidistrict projects for Fiscal Years (FY) 2013-14 (Year 16), FY 2014-2015 (Year 17), and FY 2015-2016 (Year 18). These funds were allocated towards the Carl Moyer Truck Improvement/Modernization Benefitting Emission Reductions (TIMBER) program. However, due to impending compliance deadlines, CARB staff understands that there may no longer be sufficient applicants for TIMBER projects in some air districts. Consequently, the Year 16 Carl Moyer Program Multidistrict Grant Agreements have been amended to allow the funds to be spent on school bus replacement projects and pending CARB approval, other Carl Moyer eligible projects. The Years 17 and 18 Carl Moyer Program Multidistrict Grant Agreements also had identical language that allowed the funds to be used on Carl Moyer eligible projects, pending CARB approval.

This Mail-Out is being issued to allow air districts to spend Year 17 and 18 multidistrict funds on the replacement of school buses. Additionally, it also allows air districts to spend Year 16-18 multidistrict funding on other Carl Moyer eligible projects provided that the air district makes the request to CARB in writing (or email) and CARB grants approval.
