Relating to Certification of New Heavy-Duty Motor Vehicles

WINNEBAGO INDUSTRIES, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43835 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Health and Safety Code Sections 39515 and 39516 and Executive Orders G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That 1989 model-year Winnebago Industries, Inc. motor vehicles which have a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) over 8500 pounds are certified using the gasoline engine listed below:

Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
