EXECUTIVE ORDER A-14-26
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicles

TOYOTA MOTOR COMPANY, LTD.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Health and Safety Code Sections 43100, 43102, 43103, and 43835; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Health and Safety Code Sections 39515 and 39516 and Executive Orders G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Toyota Motor Company, Ltd. exhaust emission control systems are certified as described below for 1979 model-year gasoline-powered light-duty trucks:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the listed vehicle models also comply with the Board's "Specifications for Fill Pipes and Openings of Motor Vehicle Fuel Tanks" (Title 13, California Administrative Code, Section 2290) for the aforementioned model year.

Vehicles certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
