EXECUTIVE ORDER M-2-128-2 Relating to Certification of New Motorcycles

HONDA MOTOR CO., LTD.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by the Health and Safety Code, Division 26, Part 5, Chapter 2; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Health and Safety Code Sections 39515 and 39518 and Executive Orders G-45-3 and G-45-4;

IT is ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Honda Motor Co., Ltd. has submitted its certification plan dated June 14, 1988 to meet the 1.4 grams per kilometer hydrocarbons (HC) exhaust emission standard applied as a corporate average for motorcycles with engine displacements of 700 cubic centimeters or greater. This certification plan shall apply to 1988 model-year motorcycles and contains the provisions for complying with the conditions required by Section 1958(b), Title 13 of the California Administrative Code.

BE IT F\$\$\$\$ZR RESOLVED: That before offering motorcycles of any engine family for sale, certification of the exhaust emission control system and designated engine family exhaust HC emission limit, in accordance with the approved certification plan for compilance with the corporate average standard, and certification of the appropriate evaporative emission family for the 1988 model year is required.

Executive Order M-2-128-1 for the certification plan dated September 17, 1987 is hereby cancelled.
