EXECUTIVE ORDER A-22-1
Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Saab-Scania Automotive Group engines in 1973-model heavy-duty motor vehicles are approved for the engine family described below:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Engine Size</u> CID	<u>Engine Model</u>	<u>Type</u>
Scania-California No. 2	475	Scania D8 (Mack END475)	L-6

Section 39152, Part 1, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the manufacturer's decal:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbon plus Nitrogen Dioxide</u> grams/brake horsepower-hour	<u>Carbon Monoxide</u> grams/brake horsepower-hour
Scania-California No. 2	10.0	9.1

These values are in effect until the termination of 1973-model year production.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, the California Highway Patrol, and the Bureau of Automotive Repair of the Department of Consumer Affairs will be notified of this approval by copy of this order.
