EXECUTIVE ORDER A-3

Relating to Approval of Diesel Engines
in New Motor Vehicles

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Daimler-Benz, Inc., diesel engines in 1973-model heavy-duty motor vehicles are approved for the engine families described below:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Engine Size CID</u>	<u>Engine Model</u>	<u>Type</u>
III	346.3	OM352	L6
III	346.3	OM353	L6
III	230.7	OM314	L4

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the official values to be listed on the manufacturer's decal:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbon plus Nitrogen Dioxide gms/BHP-hr</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide gms/BHP-hr</u>
Number III	9.7	5.9

These values are in effect until the termination of 1973-model year production.

The Department of Motor Vehicles, the California Highway Patrol, and the Bureau of Automotive Repair of the Department of Consumer Affairs will be notified of this approval by copy of this order.
