EXECUTIVE ORDER A-6-20 Relating to Approval of New Motor Vehicles

GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 39150 and 39151 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Section 39023 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-1;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That General Motors Corporation 1974 model year diesel-powered engines in heavy-duty motor vehicles are approved for the engine families described below:

53N	212	4L-53N	Inline-4 2-Cycle, Natural Aspiration

Section 39152, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the decal:

These values are in effect until the termination of the 1974 engine model year of production.
