EXECUTIVE ORDER A-21-7-2
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicle Engines

CUMMINS ENGINE COMPANY, INC.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100 and 43102 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That Cummins Engine Company, Inc., 1976 model-year diesel-powered engines in heavy-duty vehicles are certified for the engine family described below:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Engine Size CID</u>	<u>Engine Model</u>	<u>Type</u>
093C	855	NTC-350	Six Cylinder Inline - Turbocharged and Aftercooled

This engine is in addition to those previously approved for this engine family.

Section 43200, Part I, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the manufacturer affix a decal to the side window to the rear of the driver or, if there is no such window on the driver's side, to the windshield of the motor vehicle.

The following are the recommended values to be listed on the decal:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbon plus Nitrogen Dioxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide grams/brake horsepower-hour</u>
093C	10	3

Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
